# OT Sacrifices

---

## ◉ *Leviticus 1*

- *The Burnt Offering* - **restore the relationship with God.**

## ◉ *Leviticus 2*

- *The Grain Offering* - **recognition of God's blessing and was an outward expression of devotion**
- *The Drink Offering*

# OT Sacrifices

---

## ◉ *Leviticus 3*

- *The Fellowship Offering (Peace Offering) – given for Thanks to God.*

## ◉ *Leviticus 4*

- *The Sin Offering – forgiveness of unintentional sins*

## ◉ *Leviticus 5-6*

- *The Guilt Offering – forgiveness of unintentional sins*

# OT Sacrifices

---

- ◉ *Why does God require the sacrifice*
  - **Leviticus 17:11** “For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul.”

# OT Festivals

---

◉ *Moedim* – Appointed Times

◉ *Leviticus 23*

- V3 – Weekly Sabbath
- V5 – Passover – 14<sup>th</sup> at Twilight
- V6-8 – Unleavened Bread – 15<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>

# Passover

---

## ◉ *Exodus 12*

- V2 - It is to occurring in the first month of the Hebrew calendar
- V3 – On the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month, a lamb is to be separated from the flock
- V5 – The lamb is to be a perfect, unblemished lamb, year old (i.e.: young)
- V6 – On the 14<sup>th</sup>, the lamb is to be sacrificed at twilight

# Passover

---

## ◉ *Exodus 12*

- V7 – the blood of the lamb is placed on the two doorposts and the lintel
- V8 – that night (the first day of Unleavened Bread) the lamb is to be eaten with unleavened bread and bitter herbs
- V12-13 – God is going to strike down the firstborn of all who do not have the sign of the blood on the doorposts of their homes
