- Satan the Serpent
 - Nachash "shining one"
 - Rev 12:9 And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world;
 - Rev 20:2 And he laid hold of the dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years;
 - 2 Corinthians 11:3
 - 2 Corinthians 11:14

• Eve

- First woman
- From Adam's rib
- Adam's helper / companion
- Deceived by Satan's temptation

Adam

- The first man
- Responsible for caring for creation –
 reflects his leadership and authority
- Allows Eve to be tempted and to sin

- The Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil
 - The only tree that God forbids humans from eating its fruit
 - It is God's one boundary that He sets for humanity

- The Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil
 - It exists to prove humanity's:
 - Obedience to Him
 - Trust in His wisdom and word
 - Submission to His authority
 - Eating of its fruit results in humanity's
 - Recognizing their nakedness
 - Understanding shame
 - Separation from God

The Consequences

- A rupture in our relationship with God
- The tainting of the universe by sin
- The display of human depravity

The Grace of God

- The protoeuangelion v15
 - The first (proto) Good News (euangelion)
- The covering
 - God provides
 - The first sacrifice of a perfect animal to cover the sin of humanity
 - Evidence that we cannot do it ourselves we need God to provide for us
 - Foreshadows Jesus' sacrifice for us
